LISTEN & LEARN:

This is an introductory opportunity for completed 6th-8th graders to grow in their understanding of what it means to serve for Jesus. Students will spend 45 minutes in the word each day (with guided help from leaders) listening to God's voice. Each day will have a different study method that will teach students how to study the Bible on their own. We will also spend time each night discussing what God has been revealing to us on our own. They will also have a prayer journal, a tool designed to encourage written prayers using the ACTS prayer method.

SERVE:

Students will serve three different local ministries during the week:

1. **Texas Baptist Children's Home** (Helping children and families in need in order to empower and equip them for a promising future.)
2. **Key 2 Free** (a ministry dedicated to combating sex-trafficking)
3. **Reveal Resource Center** is a nonprofit 501(c)(3) food pantry and clothes closet serving 375 to 425 low-to moderate income families weekly

LEADERSHIP:

Students will return from an experience that will have challenged and pushed them to grow in several areas. Students will grow in passion for God's Word, spiritual maturity, and dependence on community. They will have opportunity to cook meals together, affirm one another, and will cultivate meaningful friendships during this trip.
